AHC Residency

How can I be sure you received my application?

You will receive an automatic reply from our system as soon as you submit your application and an email confirming your submission. If you do not receive a confirmation within an hour after submitting the application, please email us at ansogning@arthubcopenhagen.dk before the deadline of the open call.

I am from the UK. Can I apply to your residency?

For legal and administrative reasons, AHC can only accept applications from the EØS (see list of countries [here](#)). Unfortunately, the UK is not an EØS country, which means that AHC cannot accept applications from UK-based artists.

What is the timeline after I submit my complete application?

After the deadline, your application goes to our jury for review. The selection process may take up to two months.

Who are the jury members?

All applications will be reviewed by a jury of art professionals; three external artists or curators and two representatives from AHC. In collaboration with Art Hub Copenhagen, the jury will select the final candidates for the AHC Residency. We will announce the selected artists and jury members simultaneously.

Is there an age restriction for applying to the AHC Residency?

Applicants must be at least 18 years old. There are no other age restrictions.

Will I receive personalised feedback after a rejection?

No, we are not able to provide personalised feedback on rejected applications.

I am an artist with a practice centred on performing arts. Can I apply?

We welcome applications from visual artists working with performance. However, please note that there are limitations in terms of our facilities, as we cannot accommodate e.g. performance, dance and theatre rehearsals that require a larger space. Please consider whether the facilities described in the open call or a residency at our colleagues at [HAUT](#) will suit your practice.

Can AHC help me find accommodation in Copenhagen?

Yes, AHC will help find and support accommodation in a shared flat in the Copenhagen area. If you want your own apartment or to bring your family or dependents during your five-month stay, you have to pay for a larger apartment yourself, and AHC will then provide a subsidy.

How can I request specific accessibility support?

AHC welcomes applicants from all backgrounds, including disabled and neurodivergent artists and others who have specific needs. We are open to discussing how our residencies can be adapted to meet the needs of selected applicants.
