AHC Remote Residency

How can I calculate if I live far enough from Thoravej 29 to meet the criteria?

If you're not sure, we recommend that you use a digital map such as Google Maps. This service can measure distances between two points as the crow flies. For instructions, please [click here](#).

Can AHC help me find accommodation in Copenhagen when needed?

Yes – AHC will help you to find accommodation and will give financial support for housing and transportation in connection to participation in the part of the programme that takes place at Thoravej 29.

Is there an age restriction for applying to the AHC Remote Residency?

Applicants must be at least 18 years old. There are no other age restrictions.

I am an artist with a practice centred on performing arts. Can I apply?

We welcome applications from visual artists working with performance. But please note that our facilities are limited in certain ways: we cannot accommodate performance, dance, and theatre rehearsals that require a larger space, for example. Please consider whether the facilities described in the open call or a residency with our colleagues at [HAUT](#) will suit your practice.

How can I request specific accessibility support?

AHC welcomes applicants from all backgrounds, including disabled and neurodivergent artists and others who have specific needs. We are open to discussing how our residencies can be adapted to meet the needs of selected applicants. How can I be sure you have received my application?

You will receive an automatic reply from our system as soon as you submit your application and an email confirming your submission. If you do not receive a confirmation within an hour of submitting the application, please email us at ansogning@arthubcopenhagen.dk before the deadline of the open call.

What is the timeline after I submit my complete application?

After the deadline, your application goes to our jury for review. The selection process may take up to two months.

Who are the jury members?

All applications will be reviewed by a jury of art professionals: three external artists or curators and two representatives from AHC. We will announce the selected artists and jury members simultaneously.

Will I receive personalised feedback after a rejection?

No, we are not able to provide personalised feedback on rejected applications.
