# ART HUB COPENHAGEN X VEGA|ARTS

I samarbejde med VEGA|ARTS indtager Art Hub Copenhagen spillestedet VEGA med værker, talks og performance-program.

VEGA|ARTS er et visionært rum for samtidskunsten i VEGAs undersøgelser af nye liveformater, og hvordan VEGA kan blive et hus for flere kunststarter. Et forsøg på at følge med kunsten og artister verden over og herhjemme, der lige nu tester kategorierne for fuld skrue. Albums og live-oplevelser er lige nu utsat for radikale omvæltninger, som vil teste grænseværdier for både kunst, musik, koncert, publikum og spillested.

VEGA|ARTS er med andre ord sat i verden for at udvikle og huse nye kunstneriske metoder, oplevelser og forståelser af live-oplevelsen og dens kropslige og kollektive dimensioner i vores kultur. Nu sparkes døren ind til en ny projektfase, hvor målet er at ændre VEGA for altid.

## SAMARBEJDER ER VANEBRYDENDE

Et centralt element i VEGAs transformation er erkendelsen af, at man ikke sidder med svarene eller metoderne selv som institution. Derfor vil VEGA|ARTS også være fuld af samarbejder, take-overs og kuratoriske interventioner fra institutioner, magasiner, tech-aktører, kollektiver, kunstnere og kuratorer, der arbejder med det tværdisciplinære, det procesorienterede, det intersektionelle og det virtuelle. Det kommer der forhåbentlig nogle virkelig vilde og spændende live-oplevelser ud af.

## ART HUB COPENHAGEN TAKE-OVER

Det første institutionelle og kunstneriske samarbejde VEGA|ARTS indgår er med os her i Art Hub Copenhagen. Fra 14. oktober til 6. november indtager vi sammen med 19 kunstneres værker VEGA LAB og Lille Vega [med udstillede værker \(tre kunstnere\)](#), en [Free Lunch](#) og et bombardement af et [performanceprogram i weekenden 5.-6. november med performances af 16 kunstnere](#).

## VÆRKERNE

De installerede værker af henholdsvis Nat Bloch Gregersen og Sóley Ragnarsdóttir undersøger rummenes koder; mødet, sanserne og forventningerne, som lys-koreografi med grundstoffer og dansende, mangehovedet, malerisk velkomst, imens Mark Tholander præsenterer et tre-kanals videoværk, hvor musikere og animatorer legende fletter sig ind i værkets audiovisuelle form og udtryk.

[Performance-programmet 5. og 6. november](#) samler et stort og diverst hold af danske billede- og performancekunstnere, der i et stramt koncept vil skabe et virvar af skulpturelle situationer. De 16 værker vil indtage gulvet i Lille Vega i en undersøgelse af liveformatets muligheder mellem medier, kroppe og materialer. Dialogen mellem kunststarterne fuldendes med afsluttende koncerter hver aften.

# ART HUB COPENHAGEN X VEGA|ARTS

In collaboration with VEGA|ARTS Art Hub Copenhagen takes over the music venue VEGA bringing art, talks and performances.

VEGA|ARTS is a visionary space for contemporary art and part of VEGA's explorations of new live formats and how VEGA can become a venue for multiple artistic genres. It is an attempt at keeping up with artists in Denmark and throughout the world that are currently testing the categories. Right now, albums and live experiences are exposed to radical upheavals, testing the terms and limits of art, music, concert, audience and venue.

In other words, the VEGA|ARTS mission is to develop and host new artistic methods, experiences and notions of the live experience and its embodied, collective dimensions in our culture. VEGA|ARTS is now embarking on a new project phase, the goal of which is to change VEGA forever.

## COLLABORATIONS BREAK HABITS

A key element in the transformation of VEGA is the acknowledgement that an institution itself does not possess all the answers or methods. That is why VEGA|ARTS will also host a multitude of collaborations, takeovers and curatorial interventions by institutions, magazines, tech actors, collectives, artists and curators, whose work is interdisciplinary, process-oriented, intersectional and virtual. Hopefully this will lead to some incredibly exciting live experiences.

## THE ART HUB COPENHAGEN TAKE-OVER

The first institutional/artistic collaboration with VEGA|ARTS is with us here at Art Hub Copenhagen. From 14 October to 6 November we takeover VEGA LAB and Lille Vega, with the works of 19 different artists, inclusing **exhibitions of works (three artists)**, a **Free Lunch** and an explosive programme of **performances on the weekend of 5-6 November, featuring performances by 16 artists, followed by concerts**.

## INSTALLATIONS AND PERFORMANCES

The installations by Nat Bloch Gregersen and Sóley Ragnarsdóttir explore the spatial codes, our encounter, our senses and our expectations – in the form of a chorographic display of lights, with chemical elements and a dancing, multiheaded welcome. Meanwhile, Mark Tholander exhibits a three-channel video work, in which musicians and animators playfully intermingle with the audio-visual shapes and expression of the piece. **The works will be on show from 14 October.**

**The performance programme on 5 and 6 November** will bring together a large, diverse team of Danish visual and performance artists. Within a strict concept, they will create a welter of sculptural situations. The 16 artworks will take over the floor of Lille Vega and explore the potential of the live format through a medley of media, bodies and materials. Each evening, the dialogue between the artistic genres will culminate in a concert.
